- Class 1. Hybrid Tea, one bloom, any variety, any color
Class 2. Floribunda, one spray, any variety, any color
Class 3. Any other (grandiflora, polyantha, etc., one spray, any color/variety)

Section 2 - Annuals

- Class 4. Marigold, one bloom, large flowered, orange
Class 5. Marigold, one bloom, large flowered, yellow
Class 6. Marigold, one spray, french, any variety, any color
Class 7. Celosia, one bloom, plumed, disbudded, any variety, any color
Class 8. Celosia, one bloom, crested, any variety and color
Class 9. Strawflowers, dried, three flowers, any one color
Class 10. Cosmos, one stem, disbudded, any variety, any color
Class 11. Globe Amaranth, one spray, any one color
Class 11a. Named globe amaranth, strawberry fields, orange, three stems
Class 12. Zinnia, one stem, any variety, any color
Class 13. Sunflower, one bloom, small, up to 6", any variety, any color
Class 14. Any other round form, one bloom, named
Class 15. Any other spike form, annual, named, one spike
Class 16. Any other spray form, annual, named, one spray

Section 3 - Perennials

- Class 17. Sedum, one stem, any variety, any color
Class 18. Chrysanthemum, one spray, any variety, any color (color classes staged)
Class 19. Coreopsis, one bloom, any variety, any color
Class 20. Rudbeckia, named - one bloom of any variety
Class 21. Any round form perennial, named, one bloom, any variety, disbudded
Class 22. Any spike form perennial, named any variety, one spike
Class 23. Any spray form perennial, named any variety, one spray

Section 4 - Dahlia

- Class 24. Decorative 6" - 10", one bloom, any variety
Class 25. Decorative, 4" - 6", one bloom, any variety
Class 26. Cactus, any variety, any color
Class 27. Ball, any variety, any color
Class 28. Pompom, 2" or less, any variety any color
Class 29. Single bloom, any variety, any color

Section 5 - Foliage Only, Annuals & Perennials

- Class 30. Coleus
Class 31. Hosta
Class 32. Caladium

Section 6 - Blooming Shrubs

- Class 33. Hydrangea, one bloom, any variety
Class 34. Butterfly Bush
Class 35. Any other variety

Section 7 - House Plants

- Class 36. Flowering House Plants and Tropicals (must be in bloom)
Class 37. Foliage House Plants

Section 8 - Broadleaf Evergreens, Needled Evergreens 18" or less, Grasses

- Class 38. Other Broadleaf (Mohonia, Rhododendron or Viburnum and other)
Class 39. Pyracantha
Class 40. Berried shrubs (Cotoneaster, Euonymus)
Class 41. Needled Evergreens
Class 42. Holly (American, Hybrid or other)

- Class 43. Small Grasses, named, three stems of same variety
Class 44. Medium Grasses, named, three stems of same variety
Class 45. Large grasses, named, one stem, no specimen over 36" tall

Section 9 - Decorative & Vegetables

- Class 46. Vegetables in a Basket, 5 or more varieties, leaves and/or herbs in a basket. Exhibitor grown contents.
Class 47. Flowering Kale or Cabbage, any variety, any color, (cut in water). Container not to exceed 3 gallon bucket, bring your own container
Class 48. Gourds, at least three ornamental in a decorative container

Section 10 - Artistic Design (2 designs per club) "All in a Day's Work"

- Class 49. "January - Winter Wonderland" - a vertical design
Class 50. "February/March - Winds of Winter" - a design showing motion
Class 51. "April - April Showers" - an underwater design
Class 52. "May - Leaves of Green" - a green design foilage only, no flowers
Class 53. "June - Blossom Time" - Designer's Choice
Class 54. "July - Up a Lazy River" - a design showing water
Class 55. "August - We're Having a Heat Wave" - a creative design
Class 56. "September/October - After the Frost" - a dry design
Class 57. "November - Winter Returns" - a design incorporating wood
Class 58. "December - Merry Christmas" - a holiday design
Class 59. "Spring Is In The Air" - a design under 5 inches
Class 60. "Summer Sun" - a design over 5 inches and under 8 inches

Class 62. Wreath - not to exceed 24 inches, may be round, heart shaped or oval, any shape
