



JUNIOR FAIR CONSTITUTION

TITLE

1. This organization shall be known as the Coshocton County Junior Fair Board.

ORGANIZATION

2. The members and officers of this organization shall be charged with the responsibility of planning and conducting the Coshocton County Junior Fair, subject to the approval of the Junior Fair Advisors and the Coshocton County Agricultural Society.

MEMBERSHIP

3. The Board of Directors shall consist of 14 members from 4-H Clubs, four from Junior Grange, three from each Agricultural Education Department, four from Girl Scout troops in the county, two from Boy Scout troops in the county, and two from Farm Bureau.

4. All members of this organization must have been members of their respective 4-H Clubs, Junior Grange, Agricultural Education Department, Farm Bureau Youth Council, Girl Scout Troop or Boy Scout Troop for one year preceding their election and shall continue in such activity while serving on the board. Names of those enrolled must be recorded with the Secretary of the Coshocton County Agricultural Society.

5. The election or appointment of all Junior Fair Board members shall take place before Jan. 1. All Junior Fair Board members are elected for two-year terms.

OFFICERS

6. The outgoing, incumbent and newly-elected directors will have an evaluation meeting at a time between fair's end and the end of December, at which time nominations for the office of President, Vice President, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer and News Reporter will be made. Elections will occur and officers will assume responsibilities during the January meeting. To maintain continuity, the outgoing President will remain ex-officio member of the board.

King and Queen Contest

County Fair King and Queen are selected to reign over activities at the county fair. Applications are available at the Coshocton County Agricultural Society Office. Applicants must be a high school senior during the school year in which the fair occurs and a member of 4-H, FFA, Junior Grange, Girl Scouts, Farm Bureau Youth or Boy Scouts. Applications are returned the night of the scheduled interview and applicants are interviewed by a committee. Ballots are sent to each 4-H, FFA, Junior Grange, Farm Bureau Youth, Boy Scout and Girl Scout club, listing the final contestants. Each member of these clubs may vote for one boy and one girl on the ballot. Awards are provided by the Coshocton County Agricultural Society.



Special King and Queen awards are sponsored by the BoKay Shoppe, House of G.A. Fisher Jewelers and Royce Craft Baskets. County Fair Queen represents the Coshocton County Fair at the Ohio State Fair Queen Contest.
