

SECOND DEPARTMENT LIGHT HORSE AND PONY OPEN SHOW

JUDGING: TUESDAY, OCTOBER 2, 2007 - 9:00 a.m.

NO BEDDING WILL BE FURNISHED

Entries in this department will close 5 p.m. Saturday, September 15. Stalls are limited and will be assigned on a first come basis after entries are made. When entries are made and books closed, no changes will be permitted except upon approval of judge and superintendent in charge. The premiums of anyone who does not comply with this rule may be withheld.

All animals must remain on exhibit until 12 noon Thursday or no premiums will be paid. Horses to compete for premiums must be sound, except in cases of stallions or mares injured by accident which does not impair them for breeding purposes.

- Each horse or pony is to be assigned an individual number when entry is made.
- All horses or ponies exercised in the riding arena are to be led to and from the arena.
- 4-H horses are to be stabled in the 4-H barn.
- All horses or ponies must be entered in their proper classes and division.
- All classes are open to all light horse and pony breeds, registered and non-registered. Pony height shall be under 58" and Horse height shall be 58" and over.

EXHIBITORS WHO DO NOT ABIDE BY THE RULES OF THE DEPARTMENT WILL BE BARRED FROM EXHIBITING OR SHOWING FOR A PERIOD OF THREE (3) YEARS.

When animals are of an inferior quality, the judges shall refuse to award premiums even though there is no other competition, and in any case where the animals are not deemed worthy of first premium, the judges shall not award higher than second premium. In all cases, the exhibit must be of sufficient merit to warrant an award of any kind being made.

No one will be allowed in the show ring except the officials and the ones riding or otherwise showing the horses or ponies, during the judging of the classes. Anyone interfering with the judge or other officials during the show, will be expelled from the ring, or the judge may declare the show void, at his discretion. If help is needed by the exhibitor in the ring, permissions must be obtained from the superintendent in charge.

Should any horses or ponies be entered and not shown, the stall rent will be \$10.00 per day.

Ponies and horses may be hauled in, with permission of

department superintendent, so long as there are no stalls available.

All stallions to be shown by adults only. All other classes may be shown by child or adult, or as class indicates.

All exhibitors are to have animals in arena within reasonable time after class is called. Have your animals in paddock at the close of previous class.

NOTE - YOUTH BIRTHDATE AS OF JANUARY 1.

LEAD-IN AND WALK-TROT RIDERS ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR GAITED CLASSES.

VETERINARIAN

If veterinarian services are requested of the Fair Veterinarian during the fair, it is at the expense of the exhibitor, and all veterinary fees are to be paid by the exhibitor.
