Entries close 5 p.m. Saturday, **September 15.**

A maximum of two entries per class per exhibitor.

A breeder's young flock shall consist of one ram any age, two yearling ewes, and two ewe lambs owned and bred by exhibitor.

A pen shall consist of two ewes and two ram lambs bred by exhibitor and weaned within the year shown.

Yearlings, one year old and under two, and lambs under one year.

All entries in open class sheep breeding classes are to be registered, **with the exception of BOOK 77 MARKET BREEDING SHEEP.**

Book 77 MARKET BREEDING SHEEP are any purebred, or commercial crossbred sheep that is bred for the sole purpose of producing show market lambs. Market Breeding Sheep should be shown slick sheared with butt wool optional.
