OLD TIMERS SWINE SHOWMANSHIP

This class is open to anyone who is 19 years of age or older. Showman is required to be a 4-H or FFA parent, advisor, sponsor or involved in Coshocton County 4-H or FFA activities during the past year. Judging will be strictly on the showmanship of the individual and not on the animal. It is NOT required that the showman own the animal which they exhibit in this class. The class may be divided if necessary.

1. Dairy exhibitors will be allowed to show an unlimited number of animals with only one entry per class. Premiums will be paid for a maximum of three dairy animals plus the milking cow. The fourth entry must be a cow that is currently milking during the county fair.

2. Any heifer that has freshened will be shown in the Junior Two-Year-Old Cow class in accordance with their breed.

3. All cattle will be shown by breed.

4. Show order will be breed classes, showmanship, and Kids & Calves.

5. Awards will be presented for Grand Champion and Junior Champion of each breed. Other winners will receive rosettes.

6. Supreme Dairy Showmanship winner will represent dairy exhibitors in the auction ring during the selling of the Supreme Dairy Product.

7. Junior Division Dairy Classes - If there are four or less calves or heifers in a breed, these animals are all brought into the show ring at the same time for judging (with extra animals from one exhibitor shown by another Junior Fair exhibitor).

BOOK 570 - DAIRY SHOWMANSHIP

1. Exhibitors who have previously won Classes 1 and 2 and are still eligible in that age group cannot re-enter these classes, but are encouraged to enter the next age classification of showmanship. Once exhibitors pass into the next age group, they are eligible to show in the new age group until they win the class.

2. First-year showmanship is only for those exhibitors 12 years of age or younger as of January 1, current year,

who have not shown dairy cattle in any class before in the Coshocton County Junior Fair.

CLASS 4 - SUPREME SHOWMANSHIP

Winners of Classes 1, 2, and 3 this year and previous winners of Senior Showmanship or Supreme Showmanship. Any showman awarded first place in Supreme Showmanship may only show in the Supreme Showmanship class thereafter.

OLD TIMERS DAIRY SHOWMANSHIP

This class is open to anyone who is 19 years of age or older. Showman is required to be a 4-H or FFA parent, advisor, sponsor or involved in Coshocton County 4-H or FFA activities during the past year. Judging will be strictly on the showmanship of the individual and not on the animal. It is NOT required that the showman own the animal which they exhibit in this class. The class may be divided if necessary.

KIDS AND CALVES

There will be two classes

3-5 years inclusive (Adult must be present in ring.)

6-8 years inclusive (Presence of an adult not required.)

Classes will follow the Junior Fair Dairy Show.

Children's ages are determined as of January 1 of the current year. Calves must have been born on or after March 1 of the current year. The calves do not have to be kept on the fairgrounds for the length of the fair. The calves can be brought in on show day.

Calves should arrive at Hunter Arena before 10 a.m. on show day.

The Coshocton County Dairy Service Unit is sponsoring an ice cream sundae and an award for each child.
