

RULES: THE CONTEST WILL BE CONDUCTED UNDER THE RULES OF THE OHIO PONY PULLING ASSOCIATION.

1. Cards will be accepted from Central Ohio Pony Pullers and Hardin County Pony Pullers.
2. The distance of each full pull will be 13 feet, 6 inches.
3. Each driver will be allowed two helpers in hitching.
4. No open bridles permitted.
5. Ponies shall measure straight up from heel of front hoof to the high point and must rock back and forth over the ponies withers; no allowances for shoes.
6. Split teams will be allowed as long as the ponies involved did not pull as a team in the preceding event.
7. Each team will be driven by one driver throughout the contest except in case of injury or illness.
8. Each driver will have one minute after he hitches to the sled to get in motion; also he will have one minute rest between first

and second pull.

9. COPPA reserves the right to test any pony at any time.
10. There will be no heading of ponies on first or third pulls. Ponies can be headed on second pull if they are already hooked on the sled. No headers within the ropes going in on first or third pulls.
11. All decisions of all judges and Superintendent of the pull will be final. Any person or driver starting an argument or causing trouble of any kind with judges or officials can result in disqualification of team and driver from the event, and can be excluded from future Coshocton County Fair Pulls.
12. Coshocton Co. Agricultural Society is not responsible for accidents and animals are brought on grounds at owners risk.
