BOOK 550 - MARKET HOG SHOW

1. Market hogs must weigh a minimum of 220 pounds with no maximum weight limit. Market hogs weighing under 220 pounds will show in a separate class, and will not be eligible for champion or reserve champion. All market hogs will be eligible to sell regardless of weight.

2. All market hog classes can be divided by weight at the discretion of the superintendent. All weight sections are considered an entry in Book 550 - Class 1 and Class 2.

3. All barrows and gilts must have a measurable ½ inch of body hair, underline included. Ears and tails may be shorter length. Any barrow or gilt may be checked at any time during the exhibition. All hogs in violation will be disqualified and will not sell. Lower placing animals meeting requirements will replace these animals in showing order.

4. An exhibitor may enter two market hogs, one market barrow and one market gilt. Market gilts will be allowed to show in the Junior Fair Market Hog Show, but barrow weight classes will be separate from market gilt weight classes. A Champion and Reserve Champion Market Barrow will be selected and a Champion and Reserve Champion Market Gilt will be selected. These will compete for Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Market Hog that will sell in the auction. The top 12 market barrows and top 12 market gilts will compete for the top 16 market hogs overall for the Carcass Show. The top three market gilts and top three market barrow of 230 and above weight classes will be eligible for selection for the carcass show.

5. Market Gilt and Market Barrow class weight ranges will be printed in the Junior Fair Swine Show book.

6. Any Market Gilt or Market Barrow exhibitor not wishing to show in the Carcass Show and Champion Drive, must notify the show advisor before the animals enter the ring for Champion Drive. For the Junior Fair Swine Show, the exhibitors not wishing to show in the Champion Drive for Market Gilt or Market Barrow must decide and notify a show advisor before these two Champion Drives of 12 animals begins. Final placings of the top 16 Market Hogs must go to the Carcass Show.

7. Junior Fair Market Hog Show Champion Drive - Selection of Grand Champion Market Hog, Reserve Grand Champion Market Hog, and 14 additional market hogs for the Carcass Show. After an exhibitor has one animal in the Champion Drive selected for the Carcass Show, then he has the choice to withdraw his second animal in that Champion Drive.

**CLASS 3 - EXHIBITOR HOME BRED, BORN & RAISED
MARKET HOG**

Exhibitor or exhibitor's immediate family is to own and have the gilt or sow bred that produces the market hog. The exhibitor is not to purchase a bred gilt to produce the market hog for this class. (Must also be the exhibitor's Book 550 - Class 1 Market Barrow entry or Book 550 - Class 2 Market Gilt entry.)

BOOK 558 - SWINE SHOWMANSHIP

(See Showmanship Rules)

Exhibitor's age determined by age on January 1 of current year.

Winners of even-numbered age classes move to the next even-numbered age class the following year. Winners of odd-numbered age classes move to the next odd-numbered age class the following year.

OLD TIMERS SWINE SHOWMANSHIP

This class is open to anyone who is 19 years of age or older. Showman is required to be a 4-H or FFA parent, advisor, sponsor or involved in Coshocton County 4-H or FFA activities during the past year. Judging will be strictly on the showmanship of the individual and not on the animal. It is NOT required that the showman own the animal which they exhibit in this class. The

class may be divided if necessary.

1. Dairy exhibitors will be allowed to show an unlimited number of animals with only one entry per class. Premiums will be paid for a maximum of three dairy animals plus the milking cow. The fourth entry must be a cow that is currently milking during the county fair.
2. Any heifer that has freshened will be shown in the Junior Two-Year-Old Cow class in accordance with their breed.
3. All cattle will be shown by breed.
4. Show order will be breed classes, showmanship, and Kids & Calves.
5. Awards will be presented for Grand Champion and Junior Champion of each breed. Other winners will receive rosettes.
6. Supreme Dairy Showmanship winner will represent dairy exhibitors in the auction ring during the selling of the Supreme Dairy Product.
7. Junior Division Dairy Classes - If there are four or less calves or heifers in a breed, these animals are all brought into the show ring at the same time for judging (with extra animals from one exhibitor shown by another Junior Fair exhibitor).
8. Senior Division Dairy Classes - If there are four or less in a breed, these animals are all brought into the show ring at the same time for judging (with extra animals from one exhibitor shown by another Junior Fair exhibitor).
