GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- NO PERSON will be permitted to:
- Sell or distribute free, any merchandise
 - Post or display signs
 - Distribute handbills or advertising material
 - Make solicitations of any nature on the fairgrounds except in contracted concession, or commercially rented space.
- NO SMOKING is permitted in any barn and/or exhibition building.
- NO DOGS or other pets, except Seeing Eye or Junior Fair demonstration dogs, are permitted on the Fairgrounds.
- NO BIKES, skateboards, roller skates or in-line skates are permitted on the Fairgrounds.

GOLF CART/ATV RULES:

Anyone with a golf cart/ATV must provide proof of insurance to the fairboard office. A sticker will be provided to put on the unit as proof. Home-owners coverage is not acceptable unless a rider in the policy includes operation of golf cart/ATV. Golf cart/ATV use is limited to fairboard personnel, concessionaires, and emergency service personnel. COMMERCIAL EXHIBITORS may not remove any displays or exhibits prior to 9:00 p.m. on Thursday, October 6.

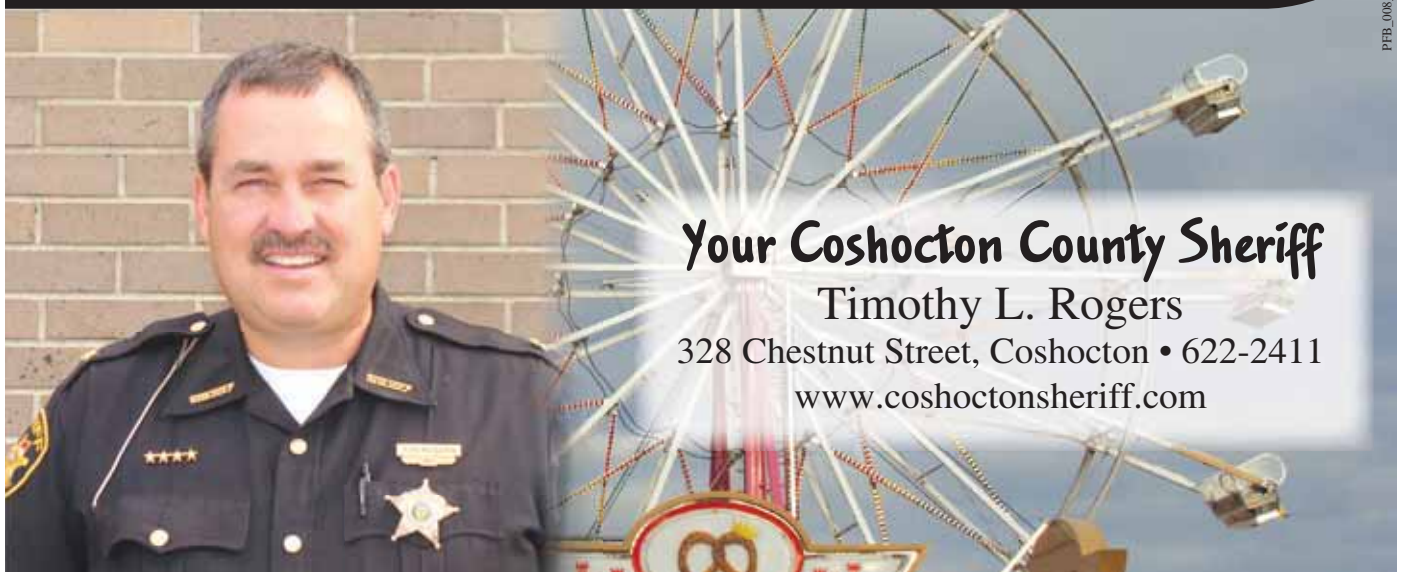
