4-WHEELER ATV'S

Driver regulations:

1. DOT approved helmets and eye protection must be worn.
2. Long pants and long-sleeved shirts must be worn during competition
3. Must attend drivers meeting prior to racing event
4. Must not be pregnant

Vehicle regulations:

1. Must have working brakes at all times
2. Tether kill switches are recommended
3. No nitrous oxide and no fuel additives.
4. No refund of entry money for violation of any rule
5. Vehicle does not need to be licensed. You may tow it in
6. All vehicles will be inspected, which means the vehicle is approved for participation in this event and shall not be constructed in any way to mean the vehicle is mechanically sound. Be it further declared that Coshocton County Agricultural Society shall not be liable or responsible for any mechanical failure, losses, injury, or death resulting from the same.

Racing regulations:

1. Decisions of the officials are final.
2. No arguing, verbal abuse or fighting will be tolerated. This will result in immediate disqualification, forfeiture of any prize money, and immediate removal from the grounds.
3. Absolutely no person will be allowed to compete under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs.
4. No alcohol or drugs permitted in the pit or restricted areas.
5. Each driver will be responsible for his/her pit crew and their actions.
6. Only one person inside of vehicle during competition.

Pit regulations:

1. Everyone located in pit area must have pit pass and release waiver must be signed for the event.
2. All participants as well as spectators must and will watch the race from designated areas as determined by the promoter and fair board.
3. Any disagreements with these rules will result in immediate removal from the restricted pit areas and possibly the fair grounds.

 Rules subject to change without notice according to Coshocton County Agricultural Society rules committee. Decisions of the officials are final.*
